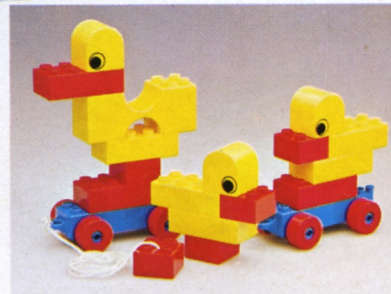

Unlike Basic Sets the Model Sets are designed to build a particular model from simple instructions. But imagination will create other models from the same bricks.



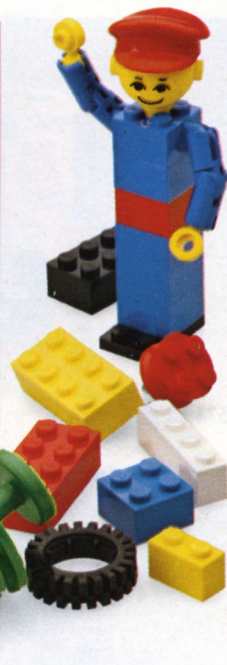

With the switch on the battery box children can start and stop the motor. The set contains motor, battery box, crawler tracks and three sets of different wheels.

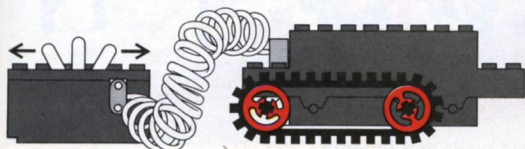

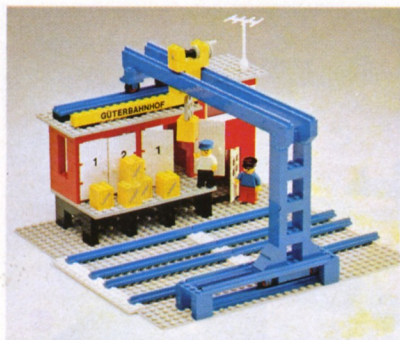
For train enthusiasts from 6 years

The most important thing about a LEGO train is that it can always be rebuilt and extended to suit changing ages and interests.



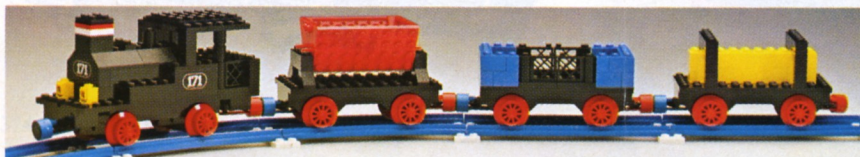
