FIRST DAY

Hall of the House of Representatives,

Austin, Texas, Monday, August 27, 1934.

In obedience of the proclamation of Her Excellency, Miriam A. Ferguson, Governor of Texas, convening the Forty-third Legislature to meet in Special Session at Austin, the seat of government, this the twenty-seventh day of August, 1934, the Members of the House of Representatives assembled in Representative Hall, and at 12 o'clock m., the House was called to order by the Hon. Coke Stevenson, Speaker.

PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

The Speaker laid before the House, and had read, the following proclamation by the Governor:

To All to Whom These Presents Shall Come:

- I, Miriam A. Ferguson, Governor of the State of Texas, do by virtue of authority vested in me by the Constitution of this State, hereby call a Special Session of the Forty-third Legislature to be convened in the City of Austin commencing at twelve o'clock noon, on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of August, A. D. 1934, for the following purposes:
- 1. To pass such law or laws as may be necessary to provide for the issuance and sale of the remaining bonds proposed and permitted under the Constitutional amendment submitted by the Legislature in 1933, and adopted by the voters of Texas at an election duly held on the 26th day of August, 1933, for the purpose of

affording relief to the unemployed

and indigent persons of the State.

2. To consider and act on such other subjects and questions as I, as Governor, may from time to time during said Called Session sumbit by message or otherwise to the consideration of the Legislature.

The Secretary of State will hereby take notice of this action and notify the Members of the Legislature.

Done at Austin, Texas, this twentieth day of August, A. D. 1934, under the Seal properly attested by the Secretary of State.
