PROCLAMATION BY THE
GOVERNOR

The Speaker laid before the House and had read the following Proclamation by the Governor:

PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS
41-901

To All to Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, Price Daniel, Governor of the State of Texas, do by virtue of authority vested in me by the Constitution of Texas, hereby call a special session, 57th Legislature, to be convened in the City of Austin, commencing at 11 a.m., Monday, the 10th day of July, A.D. 1961, for the following purposes:

1. To enact appropriations for general State services authorized under existing law or Acts of the 57th Legislature, Regular Session, for the biennium beginning September 1, 1961, and ending August 31, 1963; to provide sufficient economy and revenue measures to meet these expenditures and retire the deficit in the State Treasury, including an adequate procedure for the custody, reporting and escheat of property to which the State is entitled under present laws; and to enact improvements in the public schools, including teacher salary increases.

2. To consider and act on such other subjects and questions as the Governor may submit from time to time.

The Secretary of State will take notice of this action and will notify the Members of the Legislature.

Done at Austin, Texas, this thirtieth day of May, A.D., 1961, under the Seal of this State properly attested by the Secretary of State.

PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS
