Proclamation

by the

Governor of the State of Texas

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, Price Daniel, Governor of the State of Texas, do by virtue of authority vested in me by the Constitution of Texas, hereby call a special session, 57th Legislature, to be convened in the City of Austin, commencing at 2:00 p. m., Thursday, the 10th day of August, A.D., 1961, for the following purpose:

1. To enact improvements in the public schools, including teacher salary increases.
2. To consider and act on such other subjects and questions as the Governor may submit from time to time.

The Secretary of State will take notice of this action and will notify the members of the Legislature.

Done at Austin, Texas, this 9th day of August, A.D., 1961, under the Seal of this State properly attested by The Secretary of State.
