NOW, THEREFORE, I, GREG ABBOTT, Governor of the State of Texas, by the authority vested in me by Article III, Section 40, and Article IV, Section 8, of the Texas Constitution, do hereby amend the second subject in the proclamation of October 5, 2023, and present it for consideration by the 88th Legislature, Third Called Session, as follows:

Legislation to do more to reduce illegal immigration by creating criminal offenses for illegal entry into this state from a foreign nation and illegal reentry or presence following denial of admission, excitision, deportation, or removal; authorizing ail licensed peace officers to remove illegal immigrants from Texas; and providing indemnification of public officials, employees, or contractors in connection with the foregoing.

Legislation related to school safety measures and related state funding mechanisms.
