libraries at Providence and Manhattan so many of your

references are not available in Dublin libraries 3223
I am intrigued by your sequence 470.5. I have
not had time to consider whether it is the same as one
I suggested based on the "blasons" of Ste-Lucie (Arms des Nombrés
et des lignes f. 146). If so, I would have expected 482.5
to read 1, 2, 4, 12, 39, 202. Blasons differ for patterns
(Seq 336) in that they are non-equivalent when rotation thro
90°, 180°, 270° is allowed. Hope you can illuminate this point.

Many of the series can be strengthened by
taking account of information in others that are
closely related. A few of these I give in letter
attached
