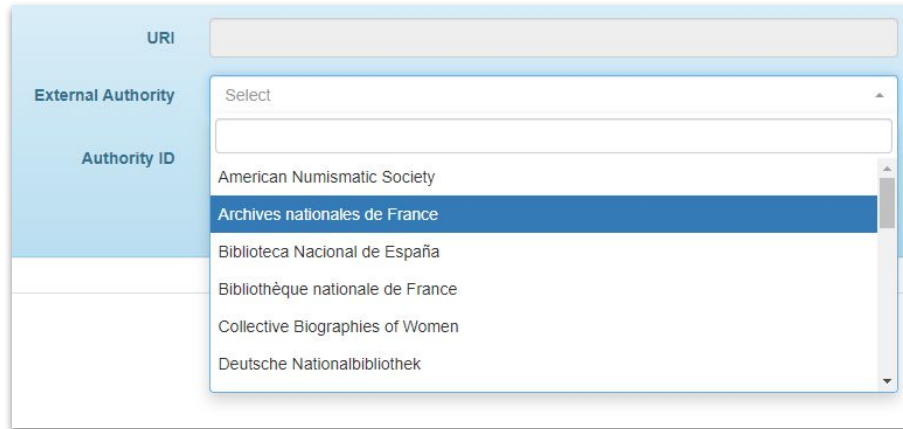

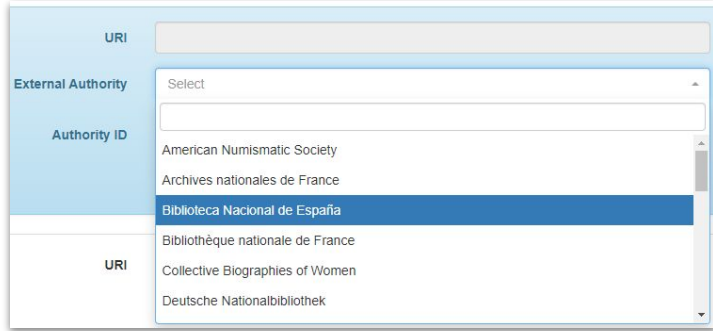

Friedrich Wilhelm Heinrich Alexander Freiherr von Humboldt Acerca de este sonido Escuchar (?) (Berlín, 14 de septiembre de 1769 - 6 de mayo de 1859), mejor conocido en español como Alejandro de Humboldt, fue un polímata: geógrafo, astrónomo, humanista, naturalista y explorador prusiano, hermano menor del lingüista y ministro Wilhelm von Humboldt. Es considerado el «padre de la Geografía Moderna Universal». Fue un naturalista de una polivalencia extraordinaria, que no volvió a repetirse tras su desaparición. Sus viajes de exploración le llevaron desde Europa a América del Sur y del Norte hasta Asia Central. Se especializó en diversas áreas de la ciencia como la etnografía, antropología, física, zoología, ornitología, climatología, oceanografía, astronomía, geografía, geología, mineralogía, botánica, vulcanología y el humanismo.

Humboldt's advocacy of long-term systematic geophysical measurement laid the foundation for modern [geomagnetic](#) and [meteorological](#) monitoring.^{[9][10]}

Between 1799 and 1804, Humboldt travelled extensively in the [Americas](#), exploring and describing them for the first time from a modern Western scientific point of view. His description of the journey was written up and published in several volumes over 21 years. Humboldt was one of the first people to propose that the lands bordering the [Atlantic Ocean](#) were once joined (South America and Africa in particular).

Humboldt resurrected the use of the word *cosmos* from the ancient Greek and assigned it to his multivolume treatise, *Kosmos*, in which he sought to unify diverse branches of scientific knowledge and culture. This important work also motivated a holistic perception of the universe as one interacting
