1. This is to certify that Dr. Jean Schneider, c/o Dr. Dupoux, 24 Avenue de France, Tunis, has released without charge a quantity of Santoquine to the United States Army for experimental and analytical purposes by the Allied Forces.

2. The chemical name of Santoquine "M" was given as the salt of the acid methylene dioxy-naphtolique.

3. Dr. Schneider has also furnished the results of personal experiments conducted during August to December 1942 in the region of Ghardimaou, Tunisia.

4. It is to be considered that, after the war, Santoquine will be the scientific property of Societe Parisienne d'Expansion Chimique - Specia Rhone Poulenc, 21 Rue Jean Goujon, Paris.
