
MAKING QUALITY HEALTHCARE ACCESSIBLE TO THE NEEDIEST

SAVING LIVES THROUGH EARLY DETECTION AND DIAGNOSIS OF DISEASES


Over 94% of the total patient visits supported through the Patient Welfare Programme were for laboratory services and diagnostic care accross Pakistan. Through more than 300 AKUH laboratories, the Programme is helping needy patients access high-quality laboratory services for early diagnosis of diseases and for better and preventive treatment outcomes.
