EDITION NOTES:

Phrase marks have been removed for more ease of reading but ties to indicate the continuance of the phrase have been retained. Singers should breathe before the repetition of a section of text. All other markings have been retained. Some parts have been separated into more staves as they split into two or four parts (at bars 101 and 136 respectively).

TEXT:

Psalm 5 vv. 1-3, 7, 12 & 13
