We take this opportunity to express our sincere gratitude to all delegations for their constructive engagement in the process to get to a Declaration on Future Generations.

Annexed to this letter, you will find the REV2 of the Declaration on Future Generations, which has been carefully crafted to reflect the collective insights and interventions made by Member States to date. We believe that this revised text successfully addresses the needs and interests of future generations while reflecting the priorities and actions envisioned by Member States.

At the request of some delegations, we also take this opportunity to share with you the explanation of the concepts, “future-proofing”, “anticipatory and forward-looking”, “future-oriented organizational culture” and “futures literacy” provided by the Co-Facilitators during the reading on 1 July 2024.

As indicated, the presentation of REV2 will take place on **Monday, 8 July 2024 from 3:00pm to 6:00pm in the Trusteeship Council Chamber, at the level of Permanent Representatives**. The aim of this consultation is to foster a collective understanding of the way forward. We therefore invite Permanent Representatives to focus their remarks on priorities and issues of strategic importance.
